FAQ's

- Do I have to walk 99k all at once?

No, you can spread your 99km of walking throughout the challenge month! It averages at just over 3.5km a day. If you want to exceed 99km, go for it!

- How do I track my walks?

Use your smart phone. Most already have "Health" apps installed. Alternatively use apps like Strava, Runkeeper or Map My Walk. Then each day record your KM's on the tracker enclosed.

- Do I have to set up a fundraising page?

Whether you're raising money on Facebook or Just Giving, both are a really easy way to fundraise. All funds raised this way are transferred directly into our bank account. You will also receive a sponsorship form in your pack in case you wish to collect any offline donations. These donations will help us continue our vital work.
